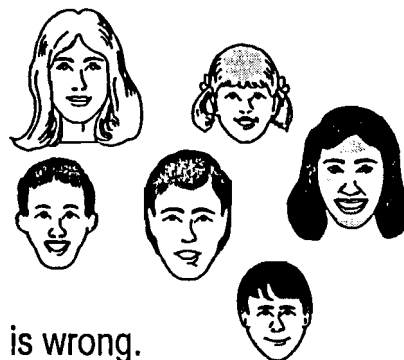


Dr. Ross is a licensed psychologist, a certified chemical dependency expert, and a seasoned adolescent specialist. He
